## WITH RESPECT TO ITS FORM 10-Q FOR THE QUARTERLY PERIOD ENDED MARCH 31, 2024

The Registrant estimates that its results of operations for the three months ended March 31, 2024, as reflected in its consolidated statements of operations to be included in its Form 10-Q for the three months ended March 31, 2024, will reflect the following changes:

For the three months ended March 31, 2024, the Registrant expects to report a decrease in revenues to approximately \$2.2 million from approximately \$6.1 million for the three months ended March 31, 2023.

This decline was almost entirely driven by the decrease in net product sales to zero due to the Company's discontinuance of all of its wholesale businesses as part of its project fundamentals plan in 2023. Licensing revenue was essentially flat year-over-year at \$2.2 million for the quarter.

Although the Company expects net loss, net loss attributable to Xcel Brands, Inc. stockholders and not loss per share - basic and diluted – will increase significantly, it has not yet quantified these amounts.
